Anita Vincent has been working with CGS for over two decades. She was the director of the CGS program at Grace Montessori School in Allentown, PA for nine years. She is a certified Montessori teacher and has several years of experience at both the primary (ages 3-6) and the lower elementary (ages 6-9) levels. Anita created an atrium in her living room to serve the children who were not enrolled at GMS. As DRE at St. Theresa's parish in Hellertown, PA, she has brought CGS to St. Theresa's and the surrounding parishes. Anita served as the Executive Director of the Center for Children and Theology for one year in 2025. Anita is an experienced Formation leader certified by the National Association of the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd in Levels 1 and 2. She has led CGS Formation courses around the country for several years. Her ongoing research focuses on serving adolescents and young adults with the method and principles that CGS is built on.

Anita is a published author, contributing to daily devotionals as well as chapters in books and peer-reviewed articles.
